Major Events Act 2014, s 9 (Important sporting event - notice)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Major Events (One Day Cricket International) Notice* 2014 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification.

3 Notice of Important Sporting Event—Act, s 9 (1) and s 10 (1) (a)

The One Day International cricket match between Australia and South Africa, as part of the Carlton Mid One-Day International (ODI) to be held at Manuka Oval in the ACT on 19 November 2014, is an Important Sporting Event.

4 Event organiser—Act, s 10 (1) (b)

The organiser of the important sporting event is Cricket Australia.

5 Proposed date—Act, s 10 (1) (c)

The proposed date of the important sporting event is 19 November 2014.

6 Proposed time—Act, s 10 (1) (c)

The proposed time of the important sporting event is as follows:

- (a) from 1:00pm when the gates are scheduled to open; to
- (b) 10:05pm when session 2 is scheduled to finish.

7 Event venue—Act, s 10 (1) (d)

The proposed location of the venue for the important sporting event is the grounds, including any buildings situated on the grounds, occupied by the Manuka Oval, at Manuka Circle, Griffith, in the ACT.

8 When notice is in force—Act, s 10 (1) (e)

This notice is in force for the period—

(a) beginning at 12:01am on 19 November 2014; and

(b) ending at 12:01am on 20 November 2014.

9 Exclusion of prohibited item—Act, s 12 (1)(a)

A flag that is longer or wider than 900mm is excluded from the definition of prohibited item.

10 Meaning of prohibited item—Act, s 12 (1)(a) and (b)

A flag that is longer or wider than 1000mm is a prohibited item.

11 Expiry

This instrument expires at 12:01am on 20 November 2014.
