Part 9.6 Executive employee and statutory office-holder leave and other entitlements

657 Meaning of recipient—pt 9.6

In this part:

recipient means—

- (a) an executive employee; and
- (b) a full-time statutory office-holder other than—
 - (i) the Chief Justice, a judge or the master; or
 - (ii) the Chief Magistrate, a magistrate or any office that must be occupied by a magistrate.

658 Leave entitlements

(1) The leave entitlements (other than long service leave) for a recipient are the leave entitlements mentioned in the ACT Public Service Administrative and Related Classifications Enterprise Agreement 2013-2017, as in force from time to time with any necessary changes to give effect to this section.

Note The agreement is available at www.jobs.act.gov.au.

- (2) However, a recipient is not entitled to annual leave loading.
- (3) The long service leave entitlements for a recipient are the leave entitlements mentioned in part 4.3 (Long service leave) with any necessary changes to give effect to this section.

659 Salary sacrifice arrangements

The salary sacrifice arrangements for a recipient are the arrangements mentioned in the *ACT Public Service Administrative* and *Related Classifications Enterprise Agreement 2013-2017*, clause D1, as in force from time to time with any necessary changes to give effect to this section.

660 Vacation childcare subsidy

The vacation childcare subsidy for a recipient is the vacation childcare subsidy mentioned in the ACT Public Service Administrative and Related Classifications Enterprise Agreement 2013-2017, clause E11, as in force from time to time with any necessary changes to give effect to this section.

Disapplication of Legislation Act, s 47 (6)
