Hassett Park	General Sir Francis George Hassett,	Inaugural Chief of Defence Force Staff.
	AC, KBE, CB, DSO, LVO (1918-2008)	Frank Hassett entered the Army through the Royal Military College, Duntroon in 1935. During World War II he served in Palestine and was wounded at Tobruk. He created a record for accelerated promotion in the Australia Army- lieutenant at 20 years of age, captain at 21, major at 22 and lieutenant colonel at 23. In 1951 he took command of 1RAR and shortly after left for Korea to command 3RAR. He was awarded an immediate Distinguished Service Order for his leadership in the Battle of Maryang San. He commanded the 28 th Commonwealth Infantry Brigade Group in Malaya 1960-63 and Australia's Northern Command 1968- 69. In 1970 he led the Army Review Committee, implementing its far reaching recommendations as Vice Chief, then Chief of the General Staff. He became Chairman, Chiefs of Staff Committee in 1975 and in 1976 became the inaugural Chief of Defence Force Staff until his retirement in 1977.
