

# Utilities (Technical Regulation) Operating Certificate Fees Determination 2016\*

Disallowable instrument DI2016–263

made under the

Utilities (Technical Regulation) Act 2014, section 110 (Determination of fees)

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## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Utilities (Technical Regulation) Operating Certificate Fees Determination 2016*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

## 3 Determination of fees

I determine the fee payable for a matter listed in column 3 of the schedule to be the fee listed in the corresponding entry in column 4 of the schedule on the date the matter is invoiced.

## 4 Payment of fees

A fee mentioned in item 1, column 4 and item 2, column 4 of the schedule is payable to the ACT Government by the person requesting the operating certificate described in the corresponding entry in column 3 of the schedule.

A fee mentioned in item 3, column 4 and item 4, column 4 is payable to the ACT Government by the unlicensed regulated utility holding the relevant operating certificate.
