#### 1 Name of instrument

## Division 5.3 Classification, salary and other entitlements

#### 5 Section 51

#### 51 SES salary

An SES member must be paid—

- (a) the base salary for the SES member's classification; and
- (b) the following additional salary, payable in fortnightly instalments:
  - (i) for a band 1 executive—\$24 000 each year;
  - (ii) for a band 2 executive—\$24 500 each year;

- (iii) for a band 3 executive—\$25 000 each year;
- (iv) for a band 4 executive—\$25 500 each year.

A part-time SES member's base salary is proportionate to the hours the Note SES member is engaged to work (see s 43, def *base salary*).

#### 52A **Parking**

- (1) An SES member is entitled to—
  - (a) a parking space at or near the SES member's ordinary place of work; or
  - (b) if the SES member requests in writing, \$2 500 each year, by fortnightly instalments, instead of a parking space.
- (2) If an SES member is engaged on a part-time basis, the engager must decide whether the SES member is entitled to—
  - (a) a parking space under subsection (1) (a); or
  - (b) a payment under subsection (1) (b) that is in proportion to the hours for which the SES member is engaged to work.

# Transitional—Public Sector Management Amendment Standards 2021 (No 1)

#### 133 Meaning of commencement day—pt 13

In this part:

commencement day means the day the *Public Sector Management Amendment Standards 2021 (No 1)*, section 3 commences.

#### 134 SES members with existing vehicle leases

- (1) This section applies if—
  - (a) an SES member leased a vehicle under repealed section 58; and
  - (b) the lease is in force on or after the commencement day.
- (2) The additional salary mentioned in section 51 (b) is not payable to the SES member for the period the lease is in force.
- (3) In this section:

*repealed section 58* means section 58 of these standards as in force immediately before the commencement day.

#### 135 Expiry—pt 13

This part expires 5 years after the commencement day.

*Note* A transitional provision is repealed on its expiry but continues to have effect after its repeal (see Legislation Act, s 88).
