1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2022 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Determination

I determine that the maximum fares relating to the hiring or use of a taxi are as specified in schedule 1 to this instrument.

4 Payment of Fare

A fare to which this determination applies is payable by a customer for using taxi services and is payable to the taxi driver with the exception of the lift fee, which is payable by the ACT Government to the taxi driver.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2021 (No 1)* DI2021-115.
