REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION NO. 109 OF 1996

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Animal Diseases Act 1993 ('the Act') provides for the control of endemic and exotic diseases of animals and for related purposes.

Under Section 63 of the Animal Diseases Act 1993 the Minister may determine fees, charges and rates payable for the purpose of this Act. This Determination sets out a fee for the provision of emergency tail tags in case the original tags are missing at the point of sale or slaughter. The tags are used for disease tracing. The fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous charges under the Stock Diseases Act 1993 which was repealed in 1993.

The fees payable under the Animal Diseases Act 1993 have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The fees payable for the purposes of the Act are set out below, the amount in brackets is the previous fee.
