DETERMINATION OF TAXI FARES

NO. 192 OF 1996

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes all existing taxi fare determinations under the Motor Traffic Act 1936, namely: -

Determination No. 128 of 1995 dated 13 September 1995 and published in the ACT Gazette No. S235 of 14 September 1995.

Taxi fares are regulated under Section 36(1) of the Motor Traffic Act 1936 which specifies that the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine the maximum fares chargeable for the hiring of a taxi. This notice is disallowable in the Legislative Assembly.

The determination reflects a 6.2% increase in taxi fares. The last taxi fare increase was implemented in September 1995. The new fares which are set out below will take effect from August 1996. The old fares are shown in brackets.
