The Dentists Act 1931 (the Act) provides for the registration of persons engaged in dental practice, and for other purposes.

This instrument revokes Determination of Fees, Disallowable Instrument No 100 of 2002 and sets new fees for initial registration pursuant to Section 18 and Section 46; fees for annual renewal registration pursuant to Section 35(1), Section 36(1) and Section 59(1); entitlement to re-registration pursuant to Section 38(1) and Section 61(1); fee for interim registration pursuant to Section 12(2), fees for alteration of particulars in the register pursuant to Section 29(3) and Section 55(2); fees for duplicate certificate pursuant to Section 27(5) and Section 53(4); fee to inspect an entry in the register pursuant to Section 83(1) and fee to obtain a certified copy of an entry in the register pursuant to Section 83(1).

The fees for initial registration, re-registration, annual renewals and other miscellaneous fees have been set at levels which reflect the administrative costs associated with those activities, and to meet the costs of operating the Health Professions Boards Secretariat.
