EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Subsection 90(1) of the *Gas Act 1992* (the Act) provides for a consumer to request that an authorised distributor arrange for the accuracy of a meter through which the distributor reticulates gas to the consumer to be tested by the Gas Technical Controller.

Subsection 91(1) of the Act provides for an authorised distributor to request the Gas Technical Controller to test the accuracy of a meter through which the distributor reticulates gas to a consumer.

In accordance with paragraph 111(1)(a) of the Act, this instrument determines the fees payable for the carrying out of such accuracy tests. The scale of fees is based upon the approved capacity of gas meters in cubic metres per hour.

The fees payable are set out in the Schedule to the instrument and are in line with those currently in force in New South Wales.
