DECLARATION OF DEFINED STOCK

No 3 of 1992

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument refers to section 11B(1) of the Stock Diseases Act 1933 and defines all stock subject to identification by a tail tag (or tattoo in the case of swine) when sold or submitted for slaughter under provisions of the Stock Diseases Act 1933. Identification of stock allows trace back of a diseased animal to a property of origin.

Stock subject to identification are cattle including buffalo, bull, ox, steer, heifer, calf and swine weighing 25 Kg or more.
