AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989 DETERMINATION NO. 50F 1992 EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989, provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice in the Gazette, to determine the names of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

Schedule A of the Determination shows the new plan layout of the affected streets within the Monash Central Estate.

Schedule B of the Determination revokes one street name in the division of Monash, due to the redesign of this area the use of ("Circuit") was not consistent with street identifiers in the Australian Capital Territory and is therefore revoked and replaced with ("Crescent") as shown on the attached map.

Schedule C of the Determination varies the location of streets. The original street development did not go ahead and the names have been reused in a different location.
