DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 116 OF 1992

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes Determination No. 76 of 1991 which was published in Australian Capital Territory Special Gazette No. S78 of 9 August 1991, and replaces it with a further Determination.

The new Determination sets fees for the purposes of the Business Franchise (Tobacco and Petroleum Products) Act 1984 and has the effect of increasing the ad valorem fees for the initial grant or renewal of tobacco wholesale (and where appropriate retail) licences that commence from 1 September 1992. The licence fees are increased from 50% to 75% of liable tobacco sales.

All other fees set by the previous Determination, including those relating to petroleum licence fees, remain unchanged.
