## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes all existing fees determinations under the Dangerous Goods Act 1984, namely:-

Determination notice dated 21 June 1991 published in Australian Capital Territory Gazette No.S56 on 1 July 1991.

This determination sets fees for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1984 and has the effect of increasing fees in respect of licences for dangerous goods issued for periods commencing on and after 1 July 1992. The fees are set out below, with previous rates shown in brackets.
