AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989 DETERMINATION NO.500F 1992 EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment, Land and Planning.

Schedule 'A' of the Determination, together with the accompanying map, details the name origin and significance of various streets within the Division of Melba.

Schedule 'B' of the Determination revokes the street names which are no longer required for the new development within the Division of Melba.
