

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY
CHIROPRACTORS REGISTRATION ACT 1983
DETERMINATION OF FEES NO: 95 1991

This Determination comes into effect on the date of Gazettal. In late May 1991 the ACT Government approved an increase in fees levied by the Health Profession Registration Boards as part of the 1991/1992 Review of Fees and Charges. The Review has subsequently been ratified by the present Cabinet.

The fees charged by Chiropractic Board of the ACT are in line with fees charged by other Australian States and in particular New South Wales. The increases are the result of deliberations by the Chiropractic Board arising out of the recent Review of the Australian Capital Territory Health Professional Registration Boards and are intended to assist the Board in working towards financial autonomy. These fees have not been increased since August 1984.

The new and (old) fees are as follows:-

Inspection of Register	\$ 5.00 (1.00)
Certified Copy of Register Entry	\$ 10.00 (2.00)
