PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989
DETERMINATION NO. 67 OF 1991

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary, Department of the Environment Land and Planning.

Schedule A of the Determination, together with accompanying maps, details the names of various public places which, by virtue of section 3 of the Public Place Names Act 1989, includes an avenue or a road, street or place which the public are entitled to use.

Schedule B of the Determination revokes the name of the northern portion of Hawdon Street Dickson. Acting on advice from the ACT Planning Authority that it does not propose to extend across the cycle path and the stormwater drain to link both portions, the northern portion has been renamed Hawdon Place. The southern link of Horbury Street Phillip has been renamed Jessup Place, following a change in planning by the ACT Planning Authority which had resulted in two separate streets with the one name.

Schedule C of the Determination, amends the significance and remarks of Christie Place and Knoke Avenue in the division of Gordon, Ferrier Place in Kambah, and Kindler Place in Monash, to correct typographical errors in Schedule A of the ACT Gazette No. 7, of 20 February 1991.
