MOTOR TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) BILL (No.2) 1998

OUTLINE

The purpose of this Bill is to require a driver to produce their driving licence on demand.

CLAUSE NOTES

Clauses 1, and 2 are formal requirements. They refer to the short title of the Bill; specify that the Bill will commence upon being notified in the *Gazette*; and identify the title of the Act being amended

Clause 3 identifies the Principal Act as the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*

Clause 4. It is an offence to fail to produce a driving licence on demand. A requirement that, in such a case, the driver had to produce the licence at a later stage has been deleted from the legislation
