EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

REMAND CENTRE REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) NO. 34 OF 1996

Section 29 of the *Remand Centres Act 1976* provides that the Executive may make Regulations for the purposes of the Act.

The Remand Centres (Amendment) Act NO. 2 of 1996 provides, *inter alia*, for paragraph (2) to be inserted in section 7 of the Remand Centres Act. This paragraph specifically authorises the Administrator to transfer a remandee outside the Territory.

The Attorney-General advised the Assembly that he would amend the Regulations to the Remand Centres Act to provide for reporting requirements to the Standing Committee on Legal Affairs when a remandee was transferred outside the Territory.

When the section commences, these Regulations are to be approved by the Minister, published in the Gazette, and will be disallowable instruments for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.

The substantive parts of these Regulations commence when section 4 of the Remand Centres (Amendment) Act NO. 2 of 1996 commences.
