EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Bill 1997

Outline

The Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Bill 1997 amends the Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Act 1996 to extend the sunset clause relating to the Construction Industry Training Fund (CITF) to 30 June 1998

The Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Act 1996 increased the training fund to 40% of income The Act, however, included a sunset clause that repealed the fund on 31 December 1997

The Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Act 1997 will commence on notice by the Minister in the Gazette

Details of the Bill

The Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Bill 1997 amends the training fund sunset clause in the Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) (Amendment) Act 1996. The fund will now cease to operate on 30 June 1998

Financial Implications

The Bill allows the CITF to continue to operate for a further six months The fund is financed from income received under the Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) Act 1981
