## **WORKERS' COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) BILL 1991**

Clause 6 of the Workers' Compensation Bill 1991 inserts a new section 6B into the Principal Act. New section 6B provides that the Minister may determine categories of workers for certain purposes. Clause 6 is amended to omit the reference to subparagraph 23G(1)(b)(i) and substitute a reference to paragraph 23F(1)(b)(i). This amendment is in response to a comment made by the Legislative Assembly Standing Committee on the Scrutiny of Bills and Subordinate Legislation in its Report No. 21 of 1991. The Committee pointed out that this cross reference was incorrect:
