Roads and Public Places (Fees) Determination 2005 (No 4)

Roads and Public Places ACT 1937, Section 9A – Fee Determinations

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument determines a new fee for the use of road verges for vehicle displays in response to the introduction of a permit system that gives Motor Vehicle Dealers permissive occupancy of public land for vehicle displays within the ACT.

The fees determined in this schedule are payable to the ACT Government by the person(s) requesting the goods or services.

Under section 9 of the Roads and Public Places Act 1937, the Minister has the power to determine fees.

This Instrument commences on 1 November 2005.
