EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* authorises for the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for driver licence and related transactions under the road transport legislation.

The reason for this determination is to give effect to:

- the introduction of a fee for the issue of a certificate of accreditation for an accredited driving instructor (item 10); and
- an increase in the fee payable for a practical driving test (item 11).

All other fees are unchanged.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within six sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
