EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 144 of the *Domestic Animals Act 2000* (the Act) allows for the Minister to determine fees for the Act.

This determination revokes the previous fee determination (DI 2006-97) which set fees for the 2006-2007 financial year and establishes fees from 1 July 2007.

The determination increases the fees payable under the Act by the current wage price index for Canberra issued by the Australian Bureau of Statistics from 1 July 2007 (4.0%), consistent with the Government's announcement on indexing of fees and charges as part of the 2006-07 ACT Budget. The increases are rounded down to the nearest 5 cents.

The Registrar of Domestic Animals may waive or refund a fee payable. The refund amounts as set out in Schedule 2 of the instrument have also been adjusted in accordance with the current wage price index for Canberra.

The new fee determination takes effect on from 1 July 2007.
