# Race and Sports Bookmaking (Sports Bookmaking Venues) Determination 2009 (No 2)

Disallowable Instrument DI2009—31

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

The *Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001* (the Act) regulates the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. Section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This instrument revokes DI2009-25 dated 26 February 2009 and notified under the Legislation Register on 5 March 2009.

The instrument determines ACTTAB Limited sub-agencies as sports bookmaking venues by approving areas within a one-metre radius of any selling terminal owned and operated by ACTTAB Limited and located within the venues specified in the Schedule to this instrument. A selling terminal is defined as a SELPOS or AMTOTE AT 1000 selling terminal.

The Instrument amends the Schedule to the Instrument to provide for a change in the trading name of a licensed club associated with a previously determined sports bookmaking venue. The amended Schedule now reflects the change in name of the former West Belconnen Leagues Club (WBLC) to “Canberra Raiders Sports Club West Belconnen” which is a consequence of the final settlement associated with the acquisition of the former WBLC by the Canberra Raiders Group on 2 March 2009.

In all other respects the instrument has not been altered.
