EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

SEAT OF GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATION) ACT 1910 AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

MILK AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1986

No. 24, 1986

Sub-section 12(1) of the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910 provides that the Governor-General may make Ordinances for the peace, order and good government of the Territory.

The Milk Authority of the Australian Capital Territory was established under the Milk Authority Ordinance 1971 (the Principal Ordinance). Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance provided that the Authority was a prescribed Authority for the purposes of the Remuneration Ordinance 1976.

In October 1985, the office of member of the Milk Authority of the Australian Capital Territory was prescribed as being a public office to which the determinations of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, should apply.

The Milk Authority (Amendment) Ordinance 1986 amends the Principal Ordinance to reflect the new arrangements as to the remuneration of members of the Milk Authority.

Section 1 cites the short title as the Milk Authority (Amendment) Ordinance 1986.

Section 2 repeals the former section 9 of the Principal Ordinance and proposes a new section 9.

New section 9 has effect subject to the Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973 and provides that:

- members of the Milk Authority shall be paid such remuneration as is determined by the Remuneration Tribunal as constituted under the abovementioned Act, but where no such determination is in force, the members shall be paid such remuneration as is prescribed; and
- members of the Milk Authority shall be paid such allowances as are prescribed.
