Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance 1983
No.4 of 1983

Explanatory Statement

The Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance 1983 amends the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930 to reflect the change of name in the portfolios for the Ministries of Capital Territory and Education. The new portfolios are now known as Territories and Local Government, and Education and Youth Affairs.

Section 1 of the new Ordinance cites the short title of the proposed Ordinance as the Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance 1983.

Section 2 cites the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930 as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 3 amends section 10 of the Principal Ordinance by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Minister of State for the Capital Territory" and substituting "Minister of State for Territories and Local Government". Section 3 also amends section 10 by omitting from sub-section (4A) the words "Minister of State for Education" and substituting "Minister of State for Education and Youth Affairs".
