## AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

## INSTRUMENTS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1982

No.88 of 1982

The purpose of this Ordinance is to prescribe a new Schedule of fees for the purposes of the Instruments Ordinance 1933 ('the Principal Ordinance').

The new Schedule re-structures and simplifies the items in the Schedule of fees previously prescribed in the Seventh Schedule to the Principal Ordinance. The fees payable under the new Schedule have been set to cover the administration costs of the Office of the Registrar of Securities in the performance of its functions under the Principal Ordinance.

<u>Section 1</u> provides that the Ordinance may be cited as the Instruments (Amendment) Ordinance 1982.

<u>Section 2</u> repeals the Seventh Schedule to the Principal Ordinance and substitutes a new Schedule 7 containing the new Schedule of fees.
