MOTOR TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No.7) 1981

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No.6) 1981, (Amendment No.6), which amended the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936 to increase certain vehicle registration and other fees was gazetted on 2 November 1981. At the same time press statements were issued advising the public that the increased charges would operate from that day. Monies were collected in accordance with the amendments contained in Amendment No. 6 from 2 November 1981.

Section 2 of Amendment No.6 provided that the amendment would come into operation on a date fixed by notice in the Gazette. Subsequently, a notice fixing 5 November 1981 was published in the Gazette.

The Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No.7) 1981 (Amendment No.7) amends Amendment No. 6 to provide that the commencement date of that amendment is deemed to be 2 November 1981.

Section 1 deals with interpretation.

Section 2 deems Amendment No. 7 to come into operation on 2 November 1981.

Section 3 repeals section 2 of Amendment No.6 and substitutes a new section 2 to fix 2 November 1981 as the date of operation.
