## AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO. 3) 1981

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Motor Omnibus Services (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 3) 1981 amends the Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955 to provide that a holder of a period ticket is entitled to a refund in respect of periods of at least 2 whole days, during the currency of the ticket, if scheduled bus services are not conducted.

Section 1 deals with interpretation.

 $$\operatorname{Section}\ 2$  gives the Ordinance retrospective effect from 1 July 1981.

Section 3 inserts a new section 4E to provide that a person who purchases a weekly, monthly or quarterly ticket is entitled to a refund of a proportion of the cost of that ticket in respect of whole days on which motor omnibus services are not conducted, provided that the period for which a refund is sought is at least 2 whole days, but not including the public holidays for New Year's Day, Good Friday and Christmas Day.
