EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Alsatian Dogs (Repeal) Ordinance 1977 repeals the existing Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1936 and the Alsatian Dogs Ordinance 1961 which impose certain restrictions on the keeping of dogs variously known as Alsatian or German Shepherd. These restrictions were no longer considered necessary.

The Dog Control (Amendment) Ordinance 1977 repeals section 11 of the Dog Control Ordinance 1975 which placed a restriction on the registration of Alsatian dogs. It is consequential upon the repeal of the Alsatian Dogs Ordinance.
