EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 32 of 1968

The purpose of these amendments to the Meat Ordinance is to relieve the Director-General of Health of the obligation of personally performing many of his routine duties and functions under the Ordinance and the Regulations made under the Ordinance, and at the same time to give the Commonwealth Director of Health for the Australian Capital Territory an active supervisory power over the administration of the Ordinance. These changes will be achieved by the inclusion of section 19AA which will allow the Director-General to delegate his powers and functions under the Ordinance, and by a provision allowing the Commonwealth Director of Health to exercise all the powers and perform all the functions conferred on any officer or person under the Ordinance.
