Amendments to Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1961

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 9 of 1962

The proposed amendments to the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1961 substantially provide for –

- (a) the establishment of a small committee representative of the body of Visiting Medical Officers, to be known as the Medical Advisory Committee, to make recommendations to the Medical Superintendent on matters of medical significance in relation to the Hospital (Section 24A);
- (b) the appointment by the Hospital Board of visiting and honorary medical practitioners and dentists at the Hospital (Section 25A); and
- (c) the exercise of clinical control of the Hospital by the Medical Superintendent by giving him authority to refuse or impose conditions on the use of the Hospital's facilities for the performance of surgical operations or medical procedures (Section 32A).
