LIQUOR ORDINANCE (NO.2) 1956

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 8 of 1956

This Ordinance amends the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1955 for the following purposes:-

- (1) To provide that trading hours for licensed clubs be unrestricted.
- (2) To widen the existing provisions dealing with the hours during which liquor may be served with meals, in the manner set out below:-

<u>Restaurants</u>		
Mondays to Saturdays	10 a.m. to 10 p.m.	noon to midnight.
Sundays & Christmas Day	No trading hours.	noon to 10 p.m.
<u>Hotels</u>		
Mondays to Saturdays	10 a.m. to 10 p.m.	10 a.m. to midnight
Sundays & Christmas Day	12.30 p.m. to 2 p.m. 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.	noon to 10 p.m.

- (3) To allow a period of 10 minutes after 10 p.m. during which liquor sold on the premises of a licensed hotel may be consumed and the bar cleared.

- (4) To allow a similar period of 10 minutes after the expiration of the time allowed under a special permit, during which period liquor supplied during the time of the permit may be consumed.
