The *Public Health Act 1997* ('the Act') provides for the licensing and registration of public health risk activities.

This instrument sets fees for the application, renewal and transfer of all licensable or registrable public health risk activities, specifically:

The determination exempts charities and benevolent institutions from having to pay the determined fees for the public health risk activities of Hairdressing, Infection Control and Cooling Towers and Warm Water Storage Facilities. The determination also gives medical practitioners an exemption from the need to pay the determined fees for infection control licences.
