POLICE SUPERANNUATION ORDINANCE 1946.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 4 of 1946

Under the existing Police Superannuation Ordinance a former member of the Police Force of a State may, within three months of his appointment to the Police Force of the Australian Capital Territory, pay into the Consolidated Revenue Fund, an amount equal to his contributions to the State Superannuation Fund and thereupon his service with the State Police Force shall, for superannuation purposes, be deemed to be service as a member of the Police Force of the Territory.

The purpose of the amending Ordinance is to extend the time for making such payment from three months after his appointment to six months after the date on which he takes up duty with the Police Force of the Territory.
