PUBLIC BATHS ORDINANCE 1953.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 1 of 1953

Section six of the Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1940 is being recast:-

- (1) to provide that the exclusive right to the baths for a swimming carnival may be granted to schools or other organisations as well as a swimming club, as at present;
- (2) to remove the present limitation (to seven) on the number of occasions in one season on which such exclusive right may be granted;
- (3) to require an application to be made for such exclusive right three weeks before it is proposed to be held; and
- (4) to clarify the right to make charges for admission and exclude person who do not pay those charges.
