EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 4 of 1951

This Ordinance is for the purpose of proclaiming the 12th day of June, 1951, a holiday in the Australian Capital Territory in celebration of the completion of the first fifty years from the establishment of the Commonwealth of Australia. The proclamation of the 12th June as a public holiday in the Territory is desirable to avoid the amendment of individual industrial awards applicable in the Territory.
