MOTOR OMNIBUS FARES REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 22 of 1985

The Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations (the “principal Regulations”) prescribe the fares to be charged by the Commonwealth’s bus service in Canberra. The Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations (Amendment) amend those Regulations to give effect to new fares and fare arrangements for the bus service.

Regulation 1 provides that the Regulations shall come into effect on 1 September 1985.

Regulation 2 deals with interpretation.

Regulation 3 amends the definition of “peak period journey” in regulation 3 of the principal Regulations to include a journey which commences at or after 4.30 pm but not later than 6 pm on a week day.

Regulation 4 repeals regulation 5 of the principal Regulations and inserts new regulations 5 and 5A which provide as follows:

- regulation 5 provides that the fare for a child, a school student, a tertiary student, or immigrant student or a student nurse shall be 40 cents a section for a peak period journey and 30 cents a section for any other journey; and
- regulation 5A provides that the fare to be charged on a route contained wholly within the Division of City is 20 cents.

Regulation 5 provides for increases in fares as follows:

- peak hour journeys
(per section)-regulation (a) from \$0.70 to \$0.80
- concession weekly ticket
- regulation 6AA from \$3.40 to \$3.70
- monthly ticket
- regulation 6B(1) from \$35.00 to \$38.00
- concession monthly ticket
regulation 6B(3) from \$12.60 to \$14.00
- quarterly ticket
- regulation 6C from \$29.00 to \$32.00
- book of 10 tickets
- regulation 6D(1)(a) from \$5.60 to \$6.10
- book of 20 tickets
regulation 6D(1)(b) from \$11.20 to \$12.20
- book of 50 tickets
- regulation 6D(1)(c) from \$28.00 to \$30.50
- book of 10 tickets
(for prescribed persons)
- regulation 6D(3)(a) from \$2.50 to \$2.75
- book of 20 tickets (for
prescribed persons)
- regulation 6D(3)(b) from \$5.00 to \$5.50
- book of 50 tickets
(for prescribed persons)
- regulation 6D(3)(c) from \$12.50 to \$13.75
- pensioners, per section
(off peak)
- regulation 9(1)(a) from \$0.30 to \$0.40
