## FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS REGULATIONS

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

## No. 36 of 1982

The Flammable Liquids Ordinance 1976 adopts regulations made under the Inflammable Liquid Act 1915 (N.S.W.) which provide for the licensing of stores for various quantities of flammable liquids. The Flammable Liquids Regulations raise the fees prescribed for various licences as set out below. Regulation 3 amends regulation 7 as follows:
