

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

HEALTH COMMISSION REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)

No. 27 of 1983

Following the making of the Health Commission (Amendment) Ordinance 1983 which provided for the Commission to determine the terms and conditions of appointment, including remuneration and allowances of a person appointed to be a member of a committee pursuant to the Ordinance certain provisions of the Health Commission Regulations were no longer valid or necessary.

The Health Commission Regulations have therefore been amended by deleting the definitions of “Committee” and “Member of Committee” and by repealing regulation 9 which prescribed the fees and allowances paid to members of the committee.
