## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

## **INSTRUMENT NO. 249 OF 2001**

This Instrument revokes Instrument No. 99 of 2001, dated 15 May 2001 and notified in the Gazette No. S27 on 21 May 2001.

It has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for transactions relating to vehicle registration under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*.

The only changes in this determination are those that apply to heavy vehicles (gross vehicle mass over 4.5 tonnes). The changes reflect the underlying inflation for the four quarters to December 2000, 3.30 per cent, as agreed by the Australian Transport Council. The changes are implemented through changes to the *Road Transport Charges (Australian Capital Territory) Regulations 1993*, which is Commonwealth legislation that applies the charges to the ACT. The legislation is also used as template legislation for the Northern Territory, South Australia and Victoria.
