MOTOR OMNIBUS FARES REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 1 of 1974

The proposed amendments of the Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations will allow a school child to travel in a bus to and from school without payment of a fare where the distance by the most direct route between his home and school is greater than one mile.

A school child will be required to produce to the conductor the written authority of the Transport Manager before he can travel free of charge. An authority will detail the service on which, and the period during which, free travel will be permitted.

The proposed amendments will also clarify certain references to sub-regulations within the Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations.
