MILK AUTHORITY REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 6 of 1972

In order to maintain a stable situation in the milk industry pending the outcome of the Milk Authority's inquiry into the milk industry in the Australian Capital Territory, the Minister has been empowered by the Milk Authority Ordinance (No.2) 1972 to fix the retail and wholesale price of milk for a period of twelve months.

These Regulations will specify the prices at which milk will be sold in the Territory by milk factories, vendors and retail shops.
