CANBERRA THEATRE CENTRE BY-LAWS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 12 of 1967

Pursuant to the powers conferred by section 23 of the Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965-1967, the Canberra Theatre Trust has, with the approval of the Minister for the Interior, made By-laws for the management and control of the Canberra Theatre Centre.

The By-laws specify the conditions under which liquor may be sold to the public in the Theatre Centre. The provisions are similar to those of the Liquor Ordinance 1929-1966. The times during which liquor may be sold are limited to the prescribed periods defined in the By-laws.

Lost property found in the Theatre Centre must be handed to or taken into possession by an employee of the Trust. Possession of such property may be given to a person who satisfies an employee of the Trust that he is entitled to possession. The Trust may authorise the sale by auction of lost property unclaimed after three months.

With the exception of guide dogs to the blind registered under the Dogs Registration Ordinance 1926-1967, no other animals shall be permitted in the Theatre Centre without the permission of the Trust.
