AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA AND JERVIS BAY ELECTRIC SUPPLY REGULATIONS.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 8 of 1954

When charges for electricity were increased in Canberra in July 1953, charges at Jervis Bay were not altered pending an investigation into the position there. Following the investigation, by this amendment, charges for electricity are to be increased at Jervis Bay from 1½d. to 3d. per unit for power for commercial premises, and from 1½d. to 3d. per unit for secondary units for domestic and rural premises.
