## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine the name of a division or public place in writing. A determination is a disallowable instrument and must be notified in the ACT Legislation Register.

Pursuant to section 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to delegated officers of the Environment and Planning Directorate.

This instrument determines the names of three roads in the Division of Moncrieff as specified in the schedule and associated plan. The theme for the naming of public places in Moncrieff is *Musicians and those associated with the field of music*. Additionally, the theme for the naming of public places within the District of Gungahlin is *Gungahlin pioneers and homesteads*.

The number of women and men after whom divisions or public places have been named in the last 10 years, and whether the names of women are well represented, has been considered as required by the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.

This instrument commemorates two men who have contributed to various fields of Australian music and the name of a 19<sup>th</sup> century rural land holding.
