APPOINTMENTS TO THE HEALTH AND COMMUNITY CARE SERVICE BOARD

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Health and Community Care Service Board (the Board) is appointed under Part III, Division 1 of the *Health and Community Care Services Act 1996*. The Board is established to control the affairs of the Health and Community Care Service.

As specified in the Act, membership of the Board consists of the Chief Executive Officers of The Canberra Hospital and ACT Community Care as ex-officio members, a person nominated by the University of Sydney and not more than 4 other members appointed in writing by the Minister for Health and Community Care. The term of office of 2 of the 4 people appointed by the Minister expired in January 2001.

The Government has reappointed Mr Peter McPhillips as Chair of the Board and reappointed Ms Prudence Power as a member of the Board for a period of four years from the date of gazettal of the instrument.

Mr McPhillips is the managing partner at Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu and has experience on hospital boards and in hospital administration.

Ms Power is the Director of General Practice Policy at the Australian Medical Association and has considerable experience in a range of health policy and service delivery environments.

Consultation with the Standing Committee on Health, Housing and Community Care has taken place in accordance with the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*.
