APPOINTMENT

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Instrument made under subsection 5A(1) of *Surveyors Act 1967*, appoints the Chief Surveyor for the purposes of the Act.

The appointment will be a term of less than six months. This will enable the statutory functions and legislative requirements of the Chief Surveyor to continue until the provisions of the Surveyors Bill 2000 and Surveyors (Consequential Provisions) Bill 2000 are commenced and a Commissioner for Surveys appointed.

The determination is a disallowable instrument for the purpose of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.

The Legislative Assembly Standing Committee on Planning and Urban Services was consulted and has no objections to the appointment.
