EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997* establishes the Cultural Facilities Corporation.

Governing board members of the Cultural Facilities Corporation are appointed under Section 9 of the *Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997* (see also Section 79 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* for appointment of Chair).

This instrument appoints Louise Douglas as chair of the governing board. The appointment begins on the day after notification to 31 December 2018.

The appointee is not a Public Servant and this instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001*, Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under the *Legislation Act 2001*, s.229, the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

The appointment has been approved by the Minister for the Arts and Community Events, and the Standing Committee on Economic Development and Tourism has been consulted in accordance with Section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

The disallowable instrument DI2016-323 which appointed Louise Douglas for two years to 17 December 2017 is revoked.
